DALE WASSERMAN (Playwright): Mr. Wasserman wrote for theater, television and film for more than 50 years and is best known for the musical *Man of La Mancha*, a multiple Tony Award winner. He also wrote the stage play *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest*, based on Ken Kesey's novel, which has won several Tony Awards. Both shows continue to be produced nationally and internationally with an estimated 300 productions a year.

**KEN KESEY** (Novel): Mr. Kesey was born September 17, 1935 in La Junta, Colorado. He attended Stanford University and later served as an experimental subject and aide in a hospital, an experience that led to his novel *One Flew over the Cuckoo's Nest*. It was followed by *Sometimes a Great Notion* and several works of nonfiction that detailed Kesey's transformation from novelist to guru of the hippie generation.

CLAUDIO RAYGOZA (Direction and Scenic Design): NVA: Brilliant Mistake. Claudio Raygoza is the founder and Executive Artistic Director of ion theatre company where he has directed, designed and/or produced over 50 productions including penning three world premiere plays.
