
MARLENE MONTES as GINGER BROOKS

WALTON JONES | PLAYRIGHT: Mr. Jones is a 1975 graduate of the Yale School of Drama. As a teacher of acting and directing, he has served on the faculty at Yale School of Drama, and University of California, San Diego. He has directed twice on Broadway, six plays off-Broadway, including the American premiere of Howard Barker's *No End of Blame* at Manhattan Theatre Club, and over sixty plays in more than twenty regional theatres from Cambridge to Fairbanks and productions in Soviet Russia and in Tokyo. Mr. Jones was a staff director at the O'Neill National Playwrights Conference from 1980 until 1990 and directed regularly for the Yale Rep, Arena Stage, and the American Repertory Theatre. He is a former resident of Carlsbad and former Artistic Director of Carlsbad Playreaders. He is the author of *The 1940s Radio Hour* and *A 1940s Radio Christmas Carol*, both published by Samuel French.
