Francis has been an actor, director and producer in San Diego for the past 20 years. He is currently the artistic director of Backyard Renaissance which he co-founded with his wife Jessica John in 2015. He is a graduate of the Actors Studio Drama School. Recent roles include: Noises Off, Camping with Henry and Tom, The Explorers Club, Equivocation, Freud's Last Session (Lambs Players); Stupid F***ing Bird, True West, Fool for Love (Cygnet Theatre); Abigail's Party, The Dazzle, American Buffalo, An Experiment

with an Air Pump, Smokefall, The Zoo Story, Abundance, The Elephant Man, Parlour Song (Backyard Renaissance); The Behavior of Broadus (Capital Stage Company); In the Next Room, Honky (San Diego Rep); Accomplice, Suzette Who Set to Sea (La Jolla Playhouse WOW and POP Tour); A Life in the Theatre, Time Stands Still (NCRT); The Pride (Diversionary Theatre). He is a resident artist with Cygnet Theatre and recipient of the San Diego Theatre Critics Circle Award for acting and directing. He teaches at Palomar College and privately through ActorsApproach. His first play The October Night of Johnny Zero received its stage debut in November of last year.



Keiko Green* (PLAYING Annette Raleigh)

Keiko Green is a performer, playwright, and screenwriter, currently based in Los Angeles and Seattle. She was last seen in San Diego as Connie in Cygnet Theatre's *The Great Leap*, a role she originated at the Denver Center and Seattle Rep. She is a Core Company Member at Seattle's ACT Theatre, where she has been seen in *Stupid F@#\$ing Bird*, *Dangerous Liaisons*, *Bad Apples*, and *A Christmas Carol*. Other credits include: *As You*

Her plays have been produced/developed by the O'Neill National Playwrights Conference, the Kennedy Center, Atlantic Theatre Co, Ensemble Studio Theatre, the Playwrights Realm, and Seattle Rep among others. She is Chance Theatre's 2023 Playwright in Residence and holds commissions from the Old Globe, ACT Theatre, and Seattle Shakespeare Co. In the TV/film world, Keiko has been seen on NBC's Grimm and Syfy's Z Nation, as well as the feature film C.O.G. starring Jonathan Groff. He was formerly the Associate Artistic Director at Cygnet Theatre in San Diego, where he directed 18 plays and produced many others over seven seasons. This season at Cygnet he will direct the world premieres of *The Little Fellow* by Kate Hamill and *Sharon* by Keiko Green. This past year he directed *Dunsinane* by David Greig at Marin Theatre Company, *Witch* by Jen Silverman at Charlotte Conservatory Theatre, *Life Sucks* by Aaron Posner at Cygnet, and an upcoming workshop of a new opera at SDSU. At Cygnet he was the head of new play development where he commissioned 20 plays with the Bill and Judy Garrett Finish Line Festival. He has developed plays at Playwrights' Center in Minneapolis, The Theatre at Boston Court, Milwaukee Repertory Theater, The John F Kennedy Center, The O'Neill Theatre Center, Woolly Mammoth Theatre, Burning Coal Theatre, The Hub Theatre and Dual Rivet Dance Company. He has taught at San Diego State University, Grossmont College, UNCSA, and UCSD. He was the 2012-2013 William R. Kenan, Jr. Directing Fellow at The John F. Kennedy Center. God of Carnage playwright Yasmina Reza is a French dramatist, novelist, director, and actress best known for her brief satiric plays that speak to contemporary middle-class anxieties. She received acclaim for her first two plays but it was Art, which premiered in 1994 about three friends quarrelling over a work of modern art, that brought Reza wide notice. The play appeared on major stages worldwide, winning Molière Awards for best author, play, and production; a British Laurence Olivier Award for best comedy; and a Tony Award for best play. Reza continued

to receive high praise for additional works including Life × 3 in 2000 and God of Carnage which made its London debut in 2008 (subsequently winning a Laurence Olivier Award), and opened on Broadway one year later, earning a Tony Award for best play. The Broadway production exploded onto the stage in 2009 with an all-star cast that included James Gandolfini, Marcia Gay Harden, Hope Davis and Jeff

Daniels. Originally expected to run for a short period of time, the show was extended several times before it was eventually converted to an open-ended run. The power-house roles earned all four actors Tony nominations (with Harden winning one) and the play itself won the 2009 Tony Award for Best Play. Other well-known actors who took over the roles in the Broadway extension included Christine Lahti, Jimmy Smits, Annie Potts, Janet McTeer, Dylan Baker, and Lucy Liu.
