

DID YOU KNOW?

The first recorded use of roller skates tookvplace in a 1743 theater production in which actors affixed wheels to their footwear to mimic ice skating on the stage.

The wheeled debut of inventor John Joseph Merlin made a lasting impression on the historical record. The Belgium born Merlin designed the first roller skates after he moved to London in 1760. Unfortunately, his skates lacked brakes, and he lacked balance. As he attempted to skate through a masquerade party while playing a violin, he promptly plowed into a mirror, broke his instrument, and ended up with severe injuries.
